

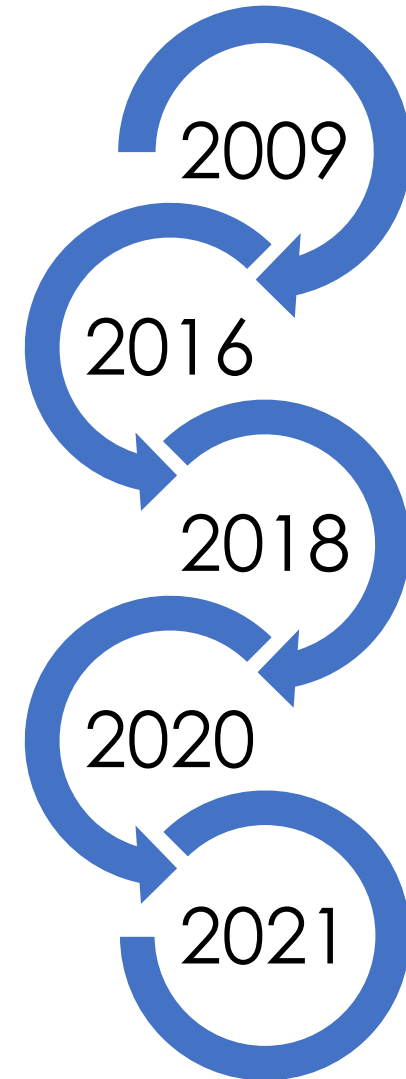

Focus of the Consultation



- **Promoting** positive mental health and social and emotional development.
- **Addressing** behavior that providers find challenging or concerning.
- **Focusing** on relationships and practices that buffer against stress and trauma.
- **Developing** a program culture that promotes the well-being of providers, young children, and families.

PDG-R Extension



Build capacity for:

- Reflective Practice & Supervision
- Understanding of developmental, behavioral, and trauma screening, Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs), and developmentally-informed trauma practices

PDG-R Extension- continued



- 12 hours of training in Reflective Practice and Supervision
- 10 months of Communities of Practice sessions to facilitate application of skill-based learning into practice
- Establish connections with the IECMHC Network to foster ongoing sustainability and facilitate linkages to state and local resources and services
